To enter your course requests, on and after the school course selection day, login via the **Student Portal in MyEdBC** (<http://www.myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspen/logon.do>). You may make changes **online** to your course requests for 2019-20 **until March 1, 2019 at 12pm**. You may view and make changes any time up to this date. After this date, any changes will need to be done with your counsellor via email.
